Musicianship: Understanding Music	I can use body percussion, instruments and voices In the key centres of: C major, F major, G major, A minor
	I can find and keep a steady beat
	I can copy back simple rhythmic patterns using long and short
	I can copy back simple melodic patterns using high and low
Listening: Respond/Analyse	I can move and dance with the music
	I can find the steady beat
	I can talk about feelings created by the song/music
	I can recognise some band and orchestral instruments
	I can describe tempo as fast or slow
	I can describe dynamics as loud and quiet
	I can join in sections of the song eg. Chorus
	I can begin to understand where the music fits in the world
Singing	I can begin to understand about different styles of music
	I can demonstrate good singing posture
	I can sing songs from memory
	I can copy back intervals of an octave and fifth (high, low)
Playing Instruments	I can sing in unison
	I can rehearse and play a simple melodic instrumental part by ear or from simple notation in C major, F major and D major
Creating: Improvising	I can explore improvisation within a major scale using the notes C D E and F G A
Creating: Composing	I can create a simple melody using crotchets and minims: C D C D E C D E F C D E F G Start and ending on the note C F G F G A F G A C F G A C D Start and ending on the note F
