We wish you all a relaxing and joyful summer break.

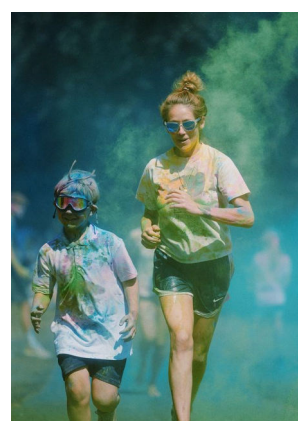

Cuckoo, Dove & Eagle Trip to Lyme Regis

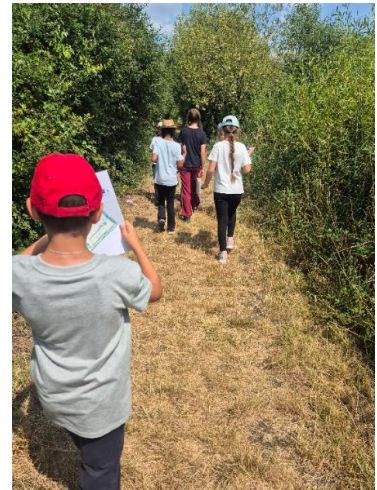
